# February 2022

The Consumer Prices Index in Phnom Penh increased 1.2% in February 2022. Over the last twelve months' prices have increased 6.3% in February 2022. In January 2022 the rate of inflation was 4.1%. The Consumer Price Index for February 2022 has been calculated at 195.4.

### February to January 2022

From February to January 2022 price for meat increased by 0.6% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increased for this group was due to increased price for pork increased by 0.6%. Price for beef increased by 0.8%; price for chicken increased by 0.5%; price for duct increased by 0.8%. Price for fish and seafood increased by 0.8% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increased for this group was due to increased price for fresh fish increased by 0.7% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for processed fish increased by 1.3%. Price for rice increased by 0.7%. Price for vegetables increased by 1.6% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increased for this group was due to increased price for leaf and stalk vegetables increased by 1.4%; price for fruits vegetables increased by 1.8% and price for root vegetables increased by 1.7%. Price for fruits increased by 1.8% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increase this group was due to increase price for fresh fruits increased by 2.0% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for sugar, jam, honey and chocolate increased by 1.2%. Price for food products increased by 1.1%. Price for milk, cheese and eggs increased by 0.7%. Price for alcoholic beverage and tobacco increased by 0.3%. Price for clothing and footwear increased by 1.0%. Main increase this group was due to increase price for clothing increased by 1.0% and price for footwear increased by 1.1%. Price for housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels increased by 0.7% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increase for this group was due to increase price for gas increased by 0.1% and solid fuels increased by 2.0%. Price for furnishings, household equipment and routine household maintenance increased by 0.5%. Price for health increased by 0.6%. Price for transport increased by 4.2% and contribution by 0.3% units. Main increase this group was due to increase price for gasoline increased by 11.2% and contribution by 0.3% units and price for diesel increased by 11.9%. Price for communication increased by 0.2%. Price for recreation and culture increased by 1.2%. Price for education increased by 0.3%. Price for restaurants increased by 1.8% and contribution by 0.2% units. Price for miscellaneous goods and services increased by 0.6%. Main increase for this group was due to increase price for personal effects increased by 0.3%.

#### February 2022 to February 2021

Of the total consumer price increased by 6.3% from February 2022 to February 2021, 3.0% units were due to increase by 5.9% for food and non-alcoholic beverages. Price for meat increased by 5.1% and contribution by 0.6% units. Main increase for this group was due to increase price for pork increased by 6.7% and contribution by 0.4% units; price for beef increased by 4.3% and price for chicken increased by 4.5% and contribution by 0.1% unit each. Price for fish and seafood increased by 6.9% and contribution by 0.9% units. Main increase for this group was due to increase price for fresh fish increased by 6.3% and contribution by 0.6% units. Price for processed fish increased by 9.6% and contribution by 0.2% units. Price for rice increased by 2.0% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for vegetables increased by 9.5% and contribution by 0.6% units. Main increase this group was due to increase price for price for leaf and stalk vegetables increased by 8.2% and price for fruits vegetables increased by 12.0% and contribution by 0.2% unit each. Price for root vegetables increased by 13.9% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for fruits increased by 8.4% and contribution by 0.5% units. Main increase this group was due to increase price for fresh fruits increased by 9.7% and contribution by 0.5% units. Price for sugar, jam, honey and chocolate increased by 7.5% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for food products increased by 6.0% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increased for food group was due to increase of rice; meat; fish and seafood; vegetables; fruits and food products. Price for alcoholic beverage and tobacco increased by 0.8%. Price for clothing and footwear increased by 9.1% and contribution by 0.2% units. Main increase this group was due to increase price for clothing increased by 8.8% and contribution by 0.2% units. Price for footwear increased by 10.3% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels increased by 6.8% and contribution by 0.8% units. Main increase for this group was

due to increase price for gas increased by 22.2% and contribution by 0.4% units. Price for furnishings, household equipment and routine household maintenance increased by 3.8% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for health increased by 4.3% and contribution by 0.2% units. Main increase for this group was due to increase price for medical products, appliance and equipment increased by 5.2% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for transport increased by 11.2% and contribution by 0.8% units. Main increase this group was due to increase price for gasoline increased by 34.3% and contribution by 0.8% units and price for diesel increased by 38.3%. Price for recreation and culture increased by 4.7% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for education increased by 1.8%. Price for restaurant increased by 7.7% and contribution by 0.7% units. Price for miscellaneous goods and services increased by 4.0% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increase for this group was due to increase price for personal effects increased by 3.9%. While, price for communication decreased by 0.3%.

The increased for all index group 6.3% rate of inflation in February 2022 was due to the subgroups such as: food and non-alcoholic beverages; alcoholic beverages and tobacco; clothing and footwear; furnishings, household equipment and routine household maintenance; housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels; health; transport; recreation and culture; education; restaurant and miscellaneous goods and services.
