## August 2023

The Consumer Prices Index in Phnom Penh was increased by 0.9% in August 2023. Over the last twelve months' prices have increased 3.2% in August 2023. In July 2023 the rate of inflation was 1.9%. The Consumer Price Index for August 2023 has been calculated at 204.8.

## **August to July 2023**

From August to July 2023 price for meat increased by 0.5% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increase this group was due to increase price for pork increased by 0.6%. Price for beef increased by 0.4%. Price for chicken increased by 0.4%. Price for duct increased by 0.5%. Price for fish and seafood increased by 0.6% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increased for this group was due to increase price for fresh fish increased by 0.5% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for processed fish increased by 0.6%. Price for fresh eggs increased by 0.4%. Price for processed eggs increased by 0.4%. Price for vegetables increased by 1.4% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increase for this group was due to increase price for leaf and stalk vegetables increased by 1.9%; price for fruit vegetables increased by 1.2%. Price for root vegetables increased by 1.8%. Price for fruits increased by 1.0% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increase this group was due to increase price for fresh fruits increased by 1.1% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for rice increased by 0.2%. Price for sugar, jam, honey and chocolate increased by 0.4%. Price for food products increased by 0.5%. Price for alcoholic beverage and tobacco increased by 0.7%. Price for clothing and footwear increased by 0.7%. Main increase this group was due to increase price for clothing increased by 0.7% and price for footwear increased by 0.7%. Price for housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels increased by 0.5% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increase for this group was due to increase price for gas increased by 1.2%. Price for liquid fuels increased by 1.4%. Price for solid fuels increased by 0.7%. Price for furnishings, household equipment and routine household maintenance increased by 0.2%. Price for health increased by 0.2%. Price for transport increased by 3.4% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increase this group was due to increase price for gasoline increased by 8.4% and contribution by 0.1% units and price for diesel increased by 17.5%. Price for communication increased by 0.1%. Price for recreation and culture increased by 0.6%. Price for restaurants increased by 1.4% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for miscellaneous goods and services increased by 0.3%.

## August 2023 to August 2022

Of the total consumer price increased by 3.2% from August 2023 to August 2022, 2.3% units were due to increase by 4.2% for food and non-alcoholic beverages. Price for meat increased by 3.1% and contribution by 0.4% units. Main increase for this group was due to increase price for pork increased by 3.2% and contribution by 0.2% units. Price for beef increased by 3.0% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for chicken increased by 2.1%. Price for duct increased by 5.6%. Price for fish and seafood increased by 4.7% and contribution by 0.6% units. Main increase for this group was due to increase price for fresh fish increased by 4.8% and contribution by 0.5% units. Price for processed fish increased by 4.8% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for rice increased by 1.7% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increase for this group was due to increase price for rice No.1 increased by 1.5% and price for rice No.2 increased by 1.8% and contribution by 0.1% unit each. Price for vegetables increased by 7.1% and contribution by 0.5% units. Main increase this group was due to increase price for leaf and stalk vegetables increased by 6.4% and price for fruits vegetables increased by 9.0% and contribution by 0.2% unit each. Price for root vegetables increased by 9.5% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for fruits increased by 6.1% and contribution by 0.4% units. Main increase this group was due to increase price for fresh fruits increased by 6.8% and contribution by 0.4% units. Price for milk, cheese and eggs increased by 2.8% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for sugar, jam, honey and chocolate increased by 5.0% and price for food products increased by 4.2% and contribution by 0.1% unit each. Main increased for food group was due to increase of rice; meat; fish and seafood; vegetables; fruits and food products. Price for alcoholic beverage and tobacco increased by 3.3%. Price for clothing and footwear increased by 4.2% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increase this group was due to increase price for clothing increased by 4.7% and contribution by 0.1% units and price for footwear increased by 2.5%. Price for housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels increased by 1.9% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increase for this group was due to increase price for liquid fuels increased by 2.7%. Price for solid fuels increased by 3.9% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for furnishings, household equipment and routine household maintenance increased by 1.7%. Main increase for this group was due to increase price for goods and services for routine household maintenance increased by 6.3%. Price for health increased by 1.6% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for transport increased by 0.2%. Main increase this group was due to increase price for gasoline increased by 0.5%. Price for communication increased by 0.4%. Price for recreation and culture increased by 3.9% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for education increased by 2.0%. Price for restaurant increased by 2.9% and contribution by 0.3% units. Price for miscellaneous goods and services increased by 3.0%. Main increase for this group was due to increase price for personal effects increased by 5.4%.

The increased for all index group 3.2% rate of inflation in August 2023 was due to the sub-groups such as: food and non-alcoholic beverages; alcoholic beverages and tobacco; clothing and footwear; housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels; furnishings, household equipment and routine household maintenance; health; transport; communication; recreation and culture; education; restaurant and miscellaneous goods and services.
